

#### Front view and keypad function:



Key	Function			
LCD screen	Display menu, time, name, Call Status			
Soft Function key	Include DND, Memo, etc			
Menu	Access the lcd menu			
Phone book	Access the phonebook			
Callers	search calls(miss calls, received, dialed)			
MWI	Indicate VM(voice mail) and dial to the mail box.			
SMS	Receive and send SIP SMS			
Transfer	Transfer the person you are conversing to another line.			
Release	Release a call without off-hook and quit to menu			
Navigation	up/down/left/right for navigation. Also for checking missed call log, IP info, incoming call log, and line status			
Hold	Hold Place the person on the other line on hold, Answering cal waiting			
Mute	Disable user's microphone, so that the people on the other			
	line cannot hear anything.			
R/Send	Redial last dialed number, access redial menu			
Speaker	Enable user to use the phone without handset.






# **Connecting IP Phone**

Connect the IP Phone as shown by the following diagram:


#### Wide Area Network/Internet

## Web Login

The configuration menu of BW320 can be accessed by Web browser with a convenient and user-friendly interface



Open your web browser (ie. Internet Explorer, firefox)

Type in the IP address of the phone

IP address is provided by your Internet Service Provider (ISP). If your ISP supports DHCP, you may obtain the IP address from your phone. Press "down" key to get IP address. You can also login from LAN port through http://192.168.10.1



Enter Username and password;

The default Username and password are "admin"

Please see the following screen after login.Include BASIC, NETWORK, VOIP, PHONE and so on.





## Network - PPPoE Setting

Select Network from the main menu.

Select PPPoE as network connection type if your ISP uses PPPoE. (Most DSL users use PPPoE.)



### Network - Static Setting

Select Static as network connection type if all Wide Area Network IP is provided to you by your ISP.





# Network - DHCP Setting

Select DHCP as network connection type that allows the network administrator to distribute IP addresses when this IP Phone is plugged into a different place in the network.

## Make a phone call

#### IP Address:

1. Lift handset  $\bigcap_{\Omega}$  or press **SPEAKER** button  $\bigcirc$ 

2. Dial IP address.

For example: dialing 192.168.0.1

# 192 \* 168 \* 0 \* 1

3. Press # or wait until the timer expires to dial.

#### SIP Number:

Note: You have to register with SIP server to use SIP number.

1. Lift handset or press SPEAKER button

2. Dial SIP number.

For example: dialing 1866

3. Press (#) or wait until the timer expires.
